1. Entries accepted Saturday, June 18<sup>th</sup> 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
2. Entries released Friday, June 24<sup>th</sup> 9:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. or Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup> 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon.
3. All entries must have been grown by the exhibitor.
4. Limit one entry per person in any one class.
5. Classes with no competition will result in second or third place money.
6. Placings and money will be given only to those entries worthy of merit received. Thus a class might begin with second or third place money.
7. All vegetables must be in the edible stage of growth.
8. Normal effort will be made to preserve and protect exhibits. However, the fair assumes no liability of spoiled, damaged or lost exhibits. Officials reserve the right to discard items which spoil prior to the end of the fair.
9. In open class competition, all crop seeds will be designated as one class. Therefore, there will be one class for all corns, wheats, soybeans, etc.
10. Each entry not finishing in the top 3 places will receive 25 cents.
