Five Classes:

Vehicles: Stock, Modified, Powder Puff; Quads and Side by Side.

Payout:

For Stock & Modified:

1st Place - \$200.00 2nd Place - \$100.00

3rd Place - \$75.00 4th Place - \$50.00

For Powder Puff, Quads & Side by Side:

1st Place - \$100.00 2nd Place - \$50.00

There will be two runs with the second turn in reverse order.

The mud pit will be two lanes 100' long. The pit may be cut down to one lane for safety reasons.

Rules:

- 1) \$25.00 per vehicle entry fee – includes one (1) pit pass per entry.
- 2) Unlimited vehicle entries.
- 3) Drivers and quad riders must have a valid driver's license.
- 4) Each driver must wear a DOT approved helmet and eye protection. Quad riders must wear a DOT approved helmet, eye protection, long pants and long sleeved shirt, gloves and boots that cover no less than 3" above the ankle.
- 5) Seatbelts must be worn.
- 6) Vehicles must have a mounted clevis. (Davies Co. Fair is not responsible for any damages due to hook up or pull out).
- 7) No passengers allowed.
- 8) Stock class is pump gas only not to exceed 93 octane, or straight diesel. No nitrous oxide. Diesel must not use propane injection.
- 9) Fighting, disorderly conduct or the presence of alcohol will result in disqualification of drivers and removal from the fairgrounds.
- 10) Release form must be signed prior to competition.
- 11) Attendance at driver's meeting is mandatory.
- 12) Open top vehicles must have a roll bar.
- 13) All tires must be Dept of Transportation (DOT) approved. No cut tires.
- 13) Driver's will have three minutes when called to the staging area. Failure to stage on time may result in disqualification.
- 14) Decisions of DCF officials are final.

Rules may not cover every incident that may occur; therefore, in those situations it will be at the discretion of track officials.

Classes:

Stock:

Vehicle must be street legal with valid plate and registration.

Must have full exhaust and muffler.

Must have factory intake and fuel system, radiator in stock position.

All lights and windows intact and in working order. Must have factory front & rear bumpers.

Pump gas not to exceed 93 octane, or straight diesel.

Tires must be 33" or under and DOT approved.

Modified:

Any size DOT tires. (No cuts)

Pump gas only not to exceed 93 octane, or diesel, no propane injection.

Powder Puff:

Open to all females.

Rules are same as modified class.

Quads:

Limited to manufactured quads. No homemade vehicles, or utility vehicles such as Gators, Rangers, Razors, etc. (Call first if uncertain).

Each vehicle must have a tethered kill switch that attaches to the riders wrist.

Riders must have valid driver's license.

Helmet, eye protection, long pants and long sleeved shirt, gloves and boots that cover no less than 3" above the ankle required.

No nitrous or alcohol type fuel will be allowed.

No two or three wheeled vehicles allowed.

Side by Side:

Limited to manufactured side by side four wheeled utility vehicles such as Gators, Rangers, Razors, etc. No homemade, quads, two or three wheeled vehicles.

Each vehicle must have a tethered kill switch that attaches to the riders wrist.

Riders must have valid driver's license.

Helmet, eye protection, long pants and long sleeved shirt, gloves and boots that cover no less than 3" above the ankle required.

No nitrous or alcohol type fuel will be allowed.

No two or three wheeled vehicles allowed.
